### Reclaiming Our Democracy Conference: A Worthwhile Event

The conference took place on Saturday December 3 at the Crowne Plaza Hotel in Harrisburg. The event was organized by Fair Districts PA. Since redistricting is on the back burner currently, the organization is focusing on making the state legislature more functional and effective. No matter what your particular interest, nothing will happen until our Pennsylvania legislature is able to function fully and pass the laws needed to support the welfare of all residents.

Kudos to Carol Kuniholm for organizing a well-planned and smooth-running event. The morning was spent with short presentations by those giving breakout sessions in the afternoon and others who produced supportive organizations or information. Lunch was provided after which we had two sets of three breakout sessions covering a variety of topics including: Business Outreach, Lessons from Redistricting in Michigan, organizing outside your usual group, learning about the "rules" our legislature uses to keep bills from discussion, and Learning to work in Coalitions with other organizations.

The PA legislature meets again in January. The first item on the agenda is setting up the rules for the next two years. Write to your representative and senator and tell them to insist the rules be set up to allow bipartisan bills to be discussed on the floor rather than being shelved by 6 people (3 in the house and 3 in the senate) who use their power to keep anything they do not like from being discussed. Not all bills are worthwhile, but many practical regulations have been ignored for years.
